## 标准与须知

### 1. 宗旨

- 1.1 奖励勤奋上进、品学兼优的在籍学生，促其力争上游，努力学习以完成学业。
- 1.2 吸引更多优秀学子到汶莱中华中学求学。

### 2. 对象

- 2.1 本校在籍中学生。

### 3. 中学学费：

- 3.1 汶币 2,900 元/年

### 4. 名额

- 4.1 名额不定，根据符合资格之学生人数为准。

### 5. 申请方式

- 5.1 无需申请，由校方根据学生的成绩进行筛选与审核。

### 6. 颁奖方式

- 6.1 本校将举办奖助学金颁发典礼（具体日期详情另行公布）。

### 7. 奖学金类别

#### 7.1 七年级

- 7.1.1 学术方面以前一年小学六年级的政府会考成绩为依据。
- 7.1.2 六年级政府会考获 5 科 A。
- 7.1.3 校内华文考试成绩：
  - 7.1.3.1 从一年级开始就读汶中者，须达 75 分或以上。
  - 7.1.3.2 从二年级至六年级开始就读汶中者，须达 80 分或以上。
- 7.1.4 操行至少乙等或以上。
- 7.1.5 前一年小学六年级时参与非学术活动或比赛者将予以加分。

#### 7.2 八年级

- 7.2.1 学术方面分别以前一年七年级的学年成绩为依据。
- 7.2.2 三科语文（华文、英文、马来文）考试成绩皆达 75 分。
- 7.2.3 数学和科学的考试成绩达 80 分。
- 7.2.4 马来伊斯兰君主概念(MIB)，社会学(Social Studies)，商学、美术与科技(BAT)，其中有 2 科的考试成绩达 80 分。
- 7.2.5 操行成绩至少乙等以上。
- 7.2.6 前一年七年级时至少参加两项非学术性活动或比赛。

### 7.3 九年级

- 7.3.1 学术方面分别以前一年的八年级的学年成绩为依据。
- 7.3.2 三科语文（华文 0509 / 0523、英文、马来文）考试成绩皆达 75 分。
- 7.3.3 数学和科学的考试成绩达 80 分。
- 7.3.4 马来伊斯兰君主概念(MIB)，社会学(Social Studies)，商学、美术与科技(BAT)，其中有 2 科的考试成绩达 80 分。
- 7.3.5 操行成绩至少乙等以上。
- 7.3.6 前一年八年级时参与非学术活动或比赛者将予以加分。

### 7.4 十年级、十一年级（理科班）

- 7.4.1 学术方面分别以前一年的九年级的学年成绩为依据。
- 7.4.2 三科语文（华文 0509 / 0523、英文、马来文）考试成绩皆达 75 分。
- 7.4.3 数学和高级数学的考试成绩达 80 分。
- 7.4.4 生物(Biology)、化学(Chemistry)、物理(Physics)和信息和通信技术(Information and Communication Technology)，其中 3 科的考试成绩达 80 分。
- 7.4.5 马来伊斯兰君主概念(MIB)和会计(POA)的考试成绩达 75 分。
- 7.4.6 操行成绩至少乙等以上。
- 7.4.7 前一年九年级、十年级时至少参加两项非学术性活动活动或比赛。

### 7.5 十年级、十一年级（文科班）

- 7.5.1 学术方面分别以前一年十年级的学年成绩为依据。
- 7.5.2 三科语文（华文 0509 / 0523、英文、马来文）考试成绩皆达 75 分。
- 7.5.3 数学(Mathematic)、综合科学(Combined Science)、信息和通信技术(Information and Communication Technology),其中 2 科考试成绩达 75 分。
- 7.5.4 马来伊斯兰君主概念(MIB)、地理(Geography)、商科(Commerce)、会计(POA)、美术与设计(Art and Design)，其中 4 科的考试成绩达 80 分。
- 7.5.5 操行成绩至少乙等以上。
- 7.5.6 前一年九年级、十年级时至少参加两项非学术性活动活动或比赛。

## 8. 非学术性活动或比赛

- 8.1 非学术性活动或比赛包括舞狮、武术、运动、露营、棋类、音乐、舞蹈、演讲、志愿活动、国际交流等。
- 8.2 非学术性活动或比赛不限于校内、校际或国际性质。
- 8.3 如以个人之名义（非代表学校）参加非学术性活动或比赛，可提交有关证明或成绩。
- 8.4 六年级与八年级为政府会考班级，参加非学术性活动或比赛为加分项。

## 9. 奖学金须知

- 9.1 校方将发函给获得奖学金的学生。
- 9.2 无法叠加获得中学全额奖学金及清寒助学金。
- 9.3 奖学金将直接抵扣学费，不提供任何现金。
- 9.4 如获得奖学金的学生已缴付部分或全年学费，可在会计部办理相关退款手续。
- 9.5 如获得奖学金的学生操行不佳，本校取消其剩余月份的奖学金资格。
- 9.6 本校的审定为最后决定，任何质询，恕不受理。
- 9.7 本奖学金标准与须知若有未尽善处，本校有权随时增删之。

# Chung Hwa Middle School Scholarship

## Criteria and Information

### 1. Objectives

- 1.1 To recognise and honour diligent and outstanding students enrolled in the school and to encourage them to strive for academic success and complete their studies
- 1.2 To attract more outstanding students to study at Chung Hwa Middle School, Bandar Seri Begawan.

### 2. Eligibility

- 2.1 Secondary school students are currently enrolled in the school.

### 3. Secondary School Fee:

- 3.1 BND2,900 per year

### 4. Number of Scholarship Recipients

- 4.1 The number of scholarship recipients is not fixed and will depend on the number of eligible students.

### 5. Application Process

- 5.1 No application is required, as the school will select and review candidates based on their academic and non-academic performance.

### 6. Award Ceremony

- 6.1 The school will hold a scholarship award ceremony, with details to be announced later.

### 7. Scholarship Categories

#### 7.1 Year 7

- 7.1.1 Academic performance is based on the previous year's Primary 6 government examination results.
- 7.1.2 Achieve 5 A's in the Primary 6 government examination
- 7.1.3 School internal Chinese examination score:
  - 7.1.3.1 For students who started at the school from Year 1, a score of 75 or above is required.
  - 7.1.3.2 For students who join between Year 2 and Year 6, a score of 80 or above is required.
- 7.1.4 The code of conduct must be at least Grade B+ or above.
- 7.1.5 Extra points will be given for participating in non-academic activities or competitions during Year 6.

#### 7.2 Year 8

- 7.2.1 Academic performance will be based on Year 7 academic results from the previous year.
- 7.2.2 Achieve 75 in all three languages (Chinese, English, Malay).
- 7.2.3 Achieve 80 in Mathematics and Science.
- 7.2.4 Achieve 80 in two of the following subjects: Melayu Islam Beraja(MIB), Social Studies or Business, Art & Technology (BAT).
- 7.2.5 The code of conduct must be at least Grade B+ or above.
- 7.2.6 Participate in at least two non-academic activities or competitions during Year 7.

### 7.3 Year 9

- 7.3.1 Academic performance will be based on the Year 8 academic results from the previous years.
- 7.3.2 Achieve 75 in all three languages (Chinese 0509/0523, English, Malay).
- 7.3.3 Achieve 80 in Mathematics and Science
- 7.3.4 Achieve 80 in two of the following subjects: Melayu Islam Beraja(MIB), Social Studies or Business, Art & Technology (BAT).
- 7.3.5 The code of conduct must be at least Grade B+ or above.
- 7.3.6 Extra points will be given to participants in non-academic activities or competitions during Year 8.

### 7.4 Year 10 and Year 11 (Science Stream)

- 7.4.1 Academic performance will be based on Year 9 or Year 10 academic results from the previous years.
- 7.4.2 Achieve 75 in all three languages (Chinese 0509/0523, English, Malay).
- 7.4.3 Achieve 80 in Mathematics and Advanced Mathematics.
- 7.4.4 Achieve 80 in three of the following subjects: Biology, Chemistry, Physics or Information and Communication Technology (ICT).
- 7.4.5 Achieve 75 in Melayu Islam Beraja(MIB) and Principles of Accounts (POA).
- 7.4.6 The code of conduct must be at least Grade B+ or above.
- 7.4.7 Participate in at least two non-academic activities or competitions during Year 9 or Year 10.

### 7.5 Year 10 and Year 11 (Arts Stream)

- 7.5.1 Academic performance will be based on Year 9 or Year 10 academic results from the previous years.
- 7.5.2 Achieve 75 in all three languages (Chinese 0509/0523, English, Malay).
- 7.5.3 Achieve 75 in two of the following subjects: Mathematics, Combined Science or Information and Communication Technology (ICT).
- 7.5.4 Achieve 80 in four of the following subjects: Melayu Islam Beraja(MIB), Geography, Commerce, Principles of Accounts (POA) or Art & Design.
- 7.5.5 The code of conduct must be at least Grade B+ or above.
- 7.5.6 Participate in at least two non-academic activities or competitions during Year 9 or Year 10

## 8. Non-Academic Activities or Competitions

- 8.1 Non-academic activities or competitions include lion dance, martial arts, sports, camping, chess, music, dance, public speaking, volunteer work, international exchanges, etc.
- 8.2 Non-academic activities or competitions can be school-level, inter-school, or international.
- 8.3 Students who participate independently in non-academic activities or competitions (not representing the school) may submit proof or results for consideration.
- 8.4 For Year 6 and Year 8, which are government examination classes, non-academic activities or competitions are considered as extra credit.

## 9. Terms and Conditions

- 9.1 Students who are awarded scholarships will be formally notified by the school.
- 9.2 Once students are awarded a scholarship, they will not be eligible for any additional scholarships or bursary.
- 9.3 Scholarships will be applied directly to waive school fees, and no cash will be provided.
- 9.4 Students who have fully or partially paid their school fees may apply for a refund at the Accounts Department.
- 9.5 If the scholarship recipient's conduct is unsatisfactory, the school reserves the right to cancel the scholarship for the remaining duration.
- 9.6 The school's decision is final, and any inquiries will not be entertained.
- 9.7 The school reserves the right to amend the terms of the scholarship as deemed necessary.
